Route:

Vado Ligure - Livorno - Barcelona - Rio de Janeiro - Santos - Buenos Aires - Montevideo - Rio Grande - Sao Francisco do Sul - Santos - Pecem - Las Palmas - Valencia - Vado Ligure.

The passage:

Nice voyage on an approved container vessel of a German shipping line to ports in Brazil, Argentina and Uruguay.

Travel regulations:

Yellow fever vaccination and valid passport required. Each passenger must provide a medical certificate. Age limit: 10 / 79.

Ship details:

Container vessel, flag Liberia, nationality of master: international, built in 2001. 30.300 TDW, length 188,12 m, breadth 30,00 m, on board voltage 220 V. Equipment: air condition, outside pool, video/TV. Table tennis, darts, deckchairs. Currency on board: US\$.

Cabins and prices:

1) Twin bedded cabin "No. 302", shower/WC. Carpet, refrigerator. Location: 4th deck. Open view to the side.

2) Twin bedded cabin "No. 303", shower/WC. Carpet, refrigerator. Location: 4th deck. View to bow restricted but open to the side.

3) Twin bedded cabin "No. 203", shower/WC. Carpet, refrigerator. Location: 5th deck. Open view to the side.

4) Twin bedded cabin "No. 204", shower/WC. Carpet, refrigerator. Location: 5th deck. View to bow restricted but open to the side.

Round trip from 3.825,- €. Part legs possible. For embarkation or disembarkation at Brazilian ports we have to take a higher port tax of EUR 250,00.

Example for part legs

1) Vado Ligure – Buenos Aires, all cabins, 21 days, 2.040,00 €, double- as single cabin 2.250,00 €.

2) Pecem – Vado Ligure, all cabins, 12 days, 1.425,00 €, double- as single caabin 1.545,00 €.
